



The 30 Acres Campground is located on the south side of Black Hawk Lake and it operated by the Iowa Department of Natural Resources. This campground offers a natural, secluded, serene setting for campers and nature-lovers.

The 30 Acres Campground has 128 sites, 89 with electricity and 10 with water. Those sites with electricity have both 30-amp and 50-amp breakers and sit on gravel pads.

There are many amenities in or nearby the 30 Acres Campground. Campers have access to an unsupervised beach; modern playground equipment; a sand volleyball court, horseshoe pits, and a disc golf course. Adjacent to the campground is a boat ramp and a shelter house. This historic shelter house was constructed during the Great Depression by the C.C.C. using native field stone. The shelter may be reserved by calling (712) 657-8712.

The Iowa DNR has one cabin for rent. This cabin is located at 227 South Blossom Street, directly adjacent to the game reserve, the Stubb Severson Memorial Trail, and the Sauk Rail Trail. This is a refurbished, modern cabin with one and a half bathrooms, four bedrooms, heat & AC. The cabin sleeps 10 and is handicap accessible. The cabin is equipped with a full size refrigerator, a stove, a microwave, a coffee pot and pots and pans. No table service is provided and the renter must furnish their own linens.
