



Camp Crescent has 250 sites and hosts approximately 35,000 people each year. Located on the west end of Black Hawk Lake, Camp Crescent offers many amenities including the following:

- Easy access to the waters of Black Hawk Lake
- Boat ramp
- Crescent Beach - large sandy beach staffed with lifeguards from 1:00-6:00 PM daily
- Playground equipment
- Shelter house. Two sand volleyball courts
- Concession stand
- Boulder Beach miniature golf course
- Walking distance of the Sauk Rail Trail and the Stub Severson Memorial Hiking Trail

Reservations are accepted for 184 of the designated sites. Around 70 sites are located in open areas and are rented on a first-come basis.

Rates are as follows:

- Lakefront: \$ 20.00 / night
- 50-amp full hook-up: \$ 20.00 / night
- Full Hook-up: \$ 18.00 / night
- Water & Elec: \$ 16.00 / night
- Electric: \$ 14.00

*If a camper stays for six consecutive nights, the seventh consecutive night is free.

Camp Crescent also has one rental cabin. The cabin is 20' X 12' with an attached 6' concrete pad with picnic table. The cabin sleeps four and is furnished with single-size bunk beds and a double-size futon. The cabin has air conditioning, refrigerator and a microwave. There is no water service to the cabin. The renter is responsible for their own towels and linens. The rental fee for the cabin is \$35.00 per night, with a two night minimum. When it is apparent that the cabin will not be rented for an entire weekend, the Campground Manager may choose to rent the cabin for a single night. Persons renting the cabin are required to post a security deposit equal to one night's rental fee which is returned if the cabin is found to be clean and in good shape. As with all sites in Camp Crescent, if the renter stays for six consecutive nights, the seventh consecutive night is free.

Visitors may stay at Camp Crescent at any time of the year, but Camp Crescent is open and staffed from April 15th until mid-November, at which time the water service is shut off for the season. After the water is shut-off, campers can stay for one-half of the daily site price.
